Why are we planting now instead of spring?

Trees and shrubs are best planted in the fall thanks to the mild temperatures and the rain. Both temperatures and rain allow the plants to grow and spread their roots. When plants have more roots they have a better chance at life during Oregon's dry summers. Also, the fall rain means people don't have to water the plants like we do when we plant in spring.
